Entries will be judged according to the criteria outlined.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

(1) Using any available information such as photographs, newspaper articles, memorabilia, old documents, etc. create a display that will be exciting, interesting as well as educational to the public. There is not a specific size for the exhibit. It can be from poster size to the size of a room. It is the historical content that is important.

(2) Submit a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5) photographs of the display from different viewpoints. All photos must be at least 4" x 6" and no more than 8" x 10.

(3) Fill out the questionnaire using additional paper if needed.
